Organizers:

The contest is organized by the partners of the Multicultural Project "Democratic Values and Linguistic Diversity" (DVALD) performed within the EU Comenius Programme – Lifelong Learning

Contest Aims:

- to design a cover for a brochure on the subject of the DVALD Project Democratic Values and Linguistic Diversity.
- the design of the cover of the brochure on "Democratic Values and Linguistic DIvesristy" must be the work by the students participating in the DVALD Project.
- The title of the brochure must be written in English.

Participation:

All the students from the participating partners in the Comenius Project are allowed to take part. They are from the partner schools in Bulgaria, Italy, Poland, Romania, Spain and Turkey.

Content:

- The title It must be typed in English.
- The author His/her name must be typed too. It must also appear:

Comenius Project "Democratic Values and Linguistic Diversity"

- The rest of the cover must be original, a freestyle cover (drawings, paintings, collage), that allows its digitalization (DIN A4).
- Your name must be written at the back of the sheet or carboard.
- The cover must be designed vertically.
- A justification explaining the design of your cover and the title of the book must be enclosed. (Minimum two sentences for each element of the design).

It is advisable to enclose the flags of the partner schools' countries in the cover. They can be excerpted from below.















Selecting the Winning Cover

Each School will choose a winning cover that will be uploaded in the Spanish webpage of the Project. In the meeting that will be held in Bulgaria (May 12 - 14), a jury composed by one teacher and one student from each country will decide the winning cover. It will be chosen from the six finalists (one per country) and that will be the brochure cover. The country which is the author of their own design cannot vote for their project.

Selection Criteria

- Adapt the cover to the Project and the content of the brochure.
- Originality.
- Other aspects to be considered by the jury.

Prizes

The Cover Winner will be awarded by their own country according to the individual rules précised by the partner countries' schools.

Deadline

In each country, students must hand in their works to the teacher in charge of this activity. The deadline for completing all the cover designs is advised to be completed at each partner school until May the 6th.

Once the winning cover of each country has been chosen, they will be sent to the general coordinator of the Project, José Félix Barrio, (IES Josefina Aldecoa -

comeniusiesja@gmail.com) so that they can be uploaded at the DVALD Project Coordinator's website.

No later than 8 May, 2014, though.
