ELEMENTS IN A COVER



1. IMAGE: photograph, drawing, mixed technique, collage (it usually makes reference to the subject

2. TITTLE: <u>In easily legible characters.</u> It stands out by its position, colour or/and size.

IMPORTANT!: The colour has to contrast with the background.

3. AUTHOR: Its name usually occupies a secondary space but it needs to be easily read.

4. PUBLISHING: In the last level of reading. It is generally printed as a logotype.

1st step before working: THINK OF THE IMAGES and SEARCH FOR INFORMATION



What are the main aspects going to be? colours? gestures? texts or images?

2º:Think about the shapes. They can show up/be displayed in very different ways.







What will its use be?

What audience is it intended?

What reading level for the image do I want?







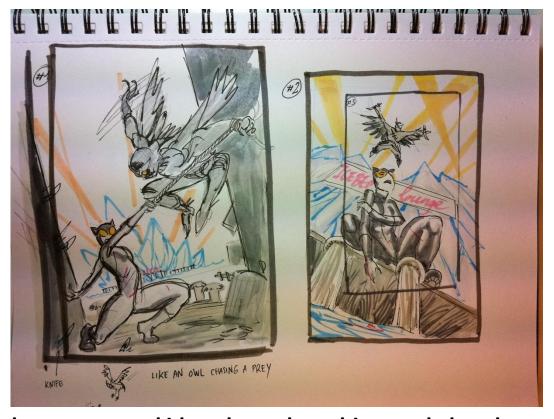


3rd Step: MAKE SKECTHES

Make more than one **sketch**: Compair and choose fonts, colours, spaces for texts and images, techniques and , so on.



Do not forget that not only the image but also the texts will shape the composition.

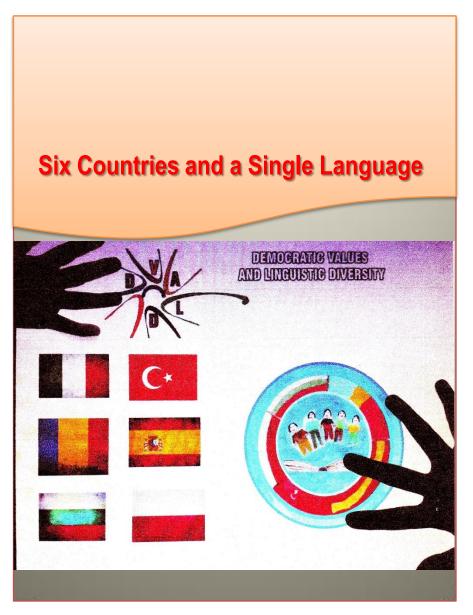


It is really important that your cover shows a general idea about the subject and also about the spirit of the Comenius Project.

- 2. It has to have an **author**:

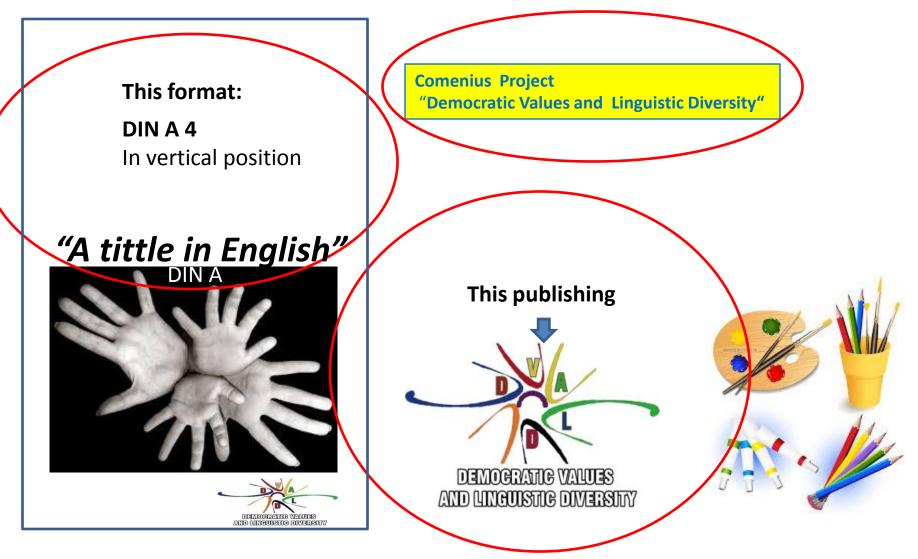
